2025 PRACTICE SCHEDULES

Regular Practices: Monday thru Friday 3:30pm - 6:00pm

Weekend Optional practices: Saturday 9-11am and Sunday 9-11am

There are 3 levels of Junior Rowing:

Junior Rec 1-2 days a week. This group is the younger athletes 12-14 y.o. that want to basic rowing but will not be ready to race yet.

Junior Comp 3-4 days a week. This group is our main group of athletes, and they practice as often as they can up to 4 times a week. They are allowed to race and compete for seats in team boats. Junior Adv 5-7 days a week. This group are the athletes that want to compete at the Regional and National level and work towards college rowing admission and scholarships. They are expected at all practices.

Notes: **Pre-Practice workout starts at 3:30**. Regular practice will begin at 4:00 for those that get out of school late.

General Team Information

Junior Adv 5-7 days a week \$400/month Junior Comp 3-4 days/week Cost: \$300/Month. Junior Rec 1-2 days/week \$200/Month

Spring Season (Jan, Feb, Mar, April and May). This includes all coaching, operations, insurance, equipment repairs, maintenance costs, Novice (new) members must also pay a \$200 Initiation Fee within 2 weeks of starting. **Scholarships are available** based on need. The scholarship form will be on TeamSnap soon.

Travel Costs are **not** included in the above fee. The travel costs will include entry fees, race day lunches and snacks, trailering, hotel and coach expenses. This does **not** include dinners and other individual expenses. Please review the Junior Crew Financial Policy for more information. Parents will sign up and pay for each regatta one month in advance.

LLVRC Junior Crew 2025 Financial Policy

1. Seasonal Dues

The current fee for LLVRC Junior Crew is \$ 400/300/200month. Athletes continuing	
in June and July will pay only \$200/150/100month. Payments are to be made by TeamSnap or Zelle each month. Junior crew fees must be paid in full by the 15 th of	Initials
each month. If payment is not received or denied, the parents will be responsible for any extra bank charges. If any charges accumulate over 30 days, we will charge you a late fee of \$25 and your athlete will be subject to land training until the past	
due amount is paid.	
2. Regatta Costs & Fees	
Each regatta will have a TeamSnap Registation associated with it and must be filled out by a parent 4 weeks prior to the regatta so that we know who will be travelling with us and we can work out the exact costs and lineups. The costs will be announced 4 weeks in advance so we can pay the entry fees and deposits with	
hotels. Parents may reserve hotel rooms on a first come first serve basis but must	Initials
check in and pay for their rooms at the hotel. Any extra charges accrued by the athletes or parents during the trips will be billed after the event. All athletes must	
travel with sufficient funds for dinners and miscellaneous costs.	
3. Junior Parent Regatta Volunteers/Fundraising	
Each athlete's parent is REQUIRED to volunteer 24 hours per year. This can be done	
at away or local regattas or any other club related function. Each Athlete is	
REQUIRED to raise a minimum of \$360 per year. This can be donations from	
parents, friends, family, or corporations. We will host an annual fundraising event in the Fall or Winter.	Initials
4. Scholarships (email Jim@llvrc.org for the scholarship form)	
The LLVRC has a limited number of financial scholarships available. Scholarships are	
awarded in partial or full amounts based on need. The amount awarded is	
determined by an LLVRC scholarship committee. Those requesting financial	
assistance must fill out the scholarship application in its entirety (including a copy	
of tax forms) and submit it by the deadline to be eligible for an award. Incomplete	
or late submissions cannot be accepted. Scholarship athletes and parents are	Initials
required to volunteer at fundraisers and home regattas during the year. Scholarship forms are due by the end of the business day on September 31st for the	
scholarship forms are due by the end of the business day on september 51 ° for the	

fall semester and **January 31st** for the spring semester. Each scholarship applicant will be notified of the committee's decision within two weeks of the deadline.



As a member of the Lake Las Vegas Rowing Club Junior Crew (LLVRC), I agree to comply with the following training rules:

- 1. In accordance with the law of the State of Nevada, LLVRC does not condone underage drinking or the use of illegal substances by its members. LLVRC provides no sanctuary from the law and recognizes its responsibility to cooperate with law enforcement officials in matters pertaining to illegal use of drugs and/or alcohol. Use of alcohol or illegal drugs while participating in any LLVRC activity will be considered inappropriate and the athlete will be subject to dismissal.
- 2. LLVRC members shall always act in a reasonable manner to assure the safety and well-being of its participants as well as non-participants.
- 3. LLVRC members shall treat all members as well as non-participants with respect and as they wish to be treated while participating in LLVRC activities.
- 4. LLVRC members shall not use words of profanity while participating in LLVRC activities.
- 5. LLVRC members shall foster an atmosphere of positive relationships, interactions, and activities and shall generally refrain from negativity concerning LLVRC fellow participants and activities.
- 6. LLVRC members shall comply with the coaches' directives while attending any LLVRC activity.
- 7. When participating in regattas, LLVRC members shall help load and unload the trailer, remain with the group unless previous approval has been granted, adhere to established team curfew, and be physically and mentally prepared to race.
